We are following State and Federal mandated and recommended guidelines for closures and cleaning during the coronavirus pandemic. Some of these will change as the season progresses and state rules change. Please check with us if you are unsure.

As of the beginning of the season, reservations available only for Maine residents or those from other states who have quarantined for the required 14 day period. We expect there will be a loosening or elimination of many requirements as the summer goes on.

Social distancing is recommended. Please keep 6 feet away. If you must be closer than 6 feet, please wear a mask.

No visitors to the campground allowed.

Some of the normal campground activities have been postponed or cancelled. Bonfires and hayrides are postponed until resumed with social distancing. Common areas and Group areas are currently closed.

Bathhouse and toilets are closed to campers with self-contained RVs. They are open to tenters' use with restrictions.

Office and store hours are limited, restricted or in some case, cancelled.

The Pavilion snack bar will remain closed for at least the beginning of the summer season.

The laundry is open with restrictions and can be occupied by only one family group at a time.

Trash pick-up is cancelled.
